## Injuries

### *Sprain or Fracture?*

It is important to check with your provider when your child is complaining about pain over a bone area. They are more likely to fracture a bone than have a sprain. We do minor treatment for sprain and fractures and can/will refer out to specialists as needed.

### *Minor Cuts and Stitches?*

Here at TLC Pediatrics, we offer treatment for minor cuts and can do minor stitches as well, depending on the child's compliance for stitches. We offer liquid bandage as well.

## Sports, School and Camp Physicals

At TLC Pediatrics, we are committed to keeping your children healthy and active. We will do a full examination to ensure your child is healthy enough for sports, school and any camps. Please allow up to a 48 hour turnaround on all sports physical forms.



## Well Child and Health Monitoring

*Newborn Check:* Jaundice check, weight check, feeding issues, newborn vaccines (if needed), parent vaccines (if needed).

*1 Month:* Physical exam, weight check, vaccines.

*2 Month:* Physical exam, weight check, growth and development, vaccines.

*4 Month:* Physical exam, weight check, growth and development, vaccines.

*6 Month:* Physical exam, weight check, growth and development, vaccines.

*9 Month:* Physical exam, weight check, growth and development, vaccines.

*12 Month:* Physical exam, weight check, growth and development, vaccines, lead and anemia screening if not done at 9 months.

*15 Month:* Physical exam, growth and development, vaccines.

*18 Month:* Physical exam, growth and development, vaccines.

*24 Month:* Physical exam, growth and development, vaccines (if needed).

*3 Year:* Physical exam, growth and development.

*4 Years & Older:* Physical exam, growth and development, vaccines, annual check-up recommended, and if needed may include finger stick (hemoglobin), urinalysis, and/or vision/hearing screening, 12 years and older also have depression screenings.
