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Immunizations are important to protect people from serious communicable childhood diseases. In accordance with the guidelines established through the American Academy of Pediatrics and the United States Public Health Service, we feel every child should receive these important vaccines. Our office only accepts patients that are immunized and/or working towards being fully immunized within the recommended intervals.

Birth: Hepatitis B

2, 4, & 6 Months: DTaP

Haemophilus B

Prevnar-13 (Pneumococcal)

Rotavirus

6 Months: Flu shot (Inactivated Influenza Virus) - Annually

9 Months: Hepatitis B

12 Months: MMR (Mumps, measles, Rubella)

Varivax (Chickenpox)

Hepatitis A

<u>15 Months:</u> Pentacel (DTaP, Haemophilus B, Inactivated Polio) Prevnar-13 (Pneumococcal)

Vaccinations Cont:

18 Months: Hepatitis A

<u>4-5 Years:</u> DTaP (Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus)

IPV (Inactivated Polio)

MMR (Mumps, Measles, Rubella)

Varivax (Chickenpox)

<u>11 Years:</u> Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)

Gardasil (Human Papillomavirus) 2 Doses, 6 months apart.

Menactra (Meningococcal) 2 Doses, 4-5 years apart.

<u>16 Years:</u> Trumenba (Meningococcal) 2 Doses, 6 months apart
